Easy to Use

The ITES-2S program is a decentralized, task ordering contract with streamlined and simplified procedures.

Any warranted contracting officer can order and execute. There is no fee for local use; however, if another contracting organization is used (e.g., ITEC4), there is a negotiated fee.

The requiring activity (customer) starts the process by providing a work statement and other documentation to the Ordering Contracting Officer (OCO), who issues a Task Order Request (TOR) to ITES-2S primes. Submitted proposals (not mandatory for all primes to submit) are evaluated and an award is made.
